


Afnic overview

IP rights and Geographical indications

- ✓ Dispute resolutions ground under .fr:
 - ✓ Potential harm to public order or prejudice to rights established by Law or Constitution
 - ✓ Potential harm to Intellectual Property rights, unless registrant has a legitimate interest and acts in good faith
 - ✓ Domaine name is identical or similar to local authority or institution or public service, unless registrant has a legitimate interest and acts in good faith
- ✓ Local authorities well recognized, same rights as trademarks :
 - ✓ Recent cases include city of Vacqueyras (which is also an PGI)
- ✓ IP rights are not restricted to trademarks :
 - √ include geographical indications



Our experience since 2007 indicates...

SIMPLE

 Setting up dispute resolution procedures that include grounds based on Geographical Indications is simple

FAIR

 It does not create prejudice to other types of IP rights (same rights – no more, no less)
