Background

6 October 2015, EP's resolution calling the Commission to "propose without delay a legislative proposal with a view to with the aim of establishing a single European system of protection of geographical indications for non-agricultural products"

In its 2015.10.28 Communication 'Upgrading the single market', the Commission committed to "take forward work on how to make the most of Europe's traditional know-how in the light of its 2014 Green Paper".



2016

As a follow-up to the Green paper, a workshop on the "contribution of non-agricultural geographically-rooted products to regional inclusive economic development" was organised (EWRC 2016). Panellists and participants confirmed that non-agricultural geographically-rooted products using 'geographical indications' have a strong potential to boost regional inclusive economic development in particular for small structures in weak and remote areas, not least via strong synergies with other economic activities like tourism.

The Commission is currently finalising an **Inception Impact Assessment** as provided for in the Better Regulation guidelines.



Next

The Inception impact assessment should be published.

The Commission will decide on the appropriate follow-up to be given to this file, in light of the results of the **Impact Assessment**.

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
