

QUMANONG MINERAL WATER (曲玛弄矿泉水)

Geographical Area: The regions of Lhasa, Tibet Damxung County Gongtang

Specificity of the Product: In the Qinghai-Tibet Plateau, known as the "third pole of the world", the total amount of glaciers is at least 100 times that of the Alps, with unparalleled natural and geographical advantages and special geological conditions. "Qu Ma get mineral water" is sourced from the majestic Nyainqentanglha snow-capped mountains, with water sources on both sides of the steep granite Hengdao on the east and west.

The local Tibetans are convinced that this water is full of heaven and earth essence, not only to cure illnesses, but also to help people keep the soul of purity. It is said that most of the herdsmen that drink from these springs enjoy health and longevity; the cattle and sheep that drink from them are never sick. "Qu Ma get mineral water" is rich in trace elements of silicic acid, lithium, strontium, the three of which meet state standards, and has an annual temperature of 23 degrees. This geographical indication is an extremely rare mineral water rare treasure. The metasilicic acid, lithium, strontium, calcium and magnesium in the mineral water can promote bone and tooth growth and development, is conducive to bone calcification, and the prevention and treatment of osteoporosis; it can also prevent high blood pressure and reduce cardiovascular and cerebrovascular morbidity and mortality. Therefore, its high level of silicic acid content, the most commonly used evaluation of mineral water quality, is one of the most important indicators of its quality.
