Specificity of the Product: The Linzhi Tibetan pig is an excellent representative of Tibetan ancient animal stock, mainly distributed in the central and southern regions of Linzhi City. In the original ecological stock from which the current pigs descend, the pigs are known for their small size and long mane. The flesh has thin amino acids and high trace element content and is low in fat. The meat is known for its delicate and fragrant taste and unique quality. It is used in a dish known as the "plateau Jane," one of the city's famous specialties.
