

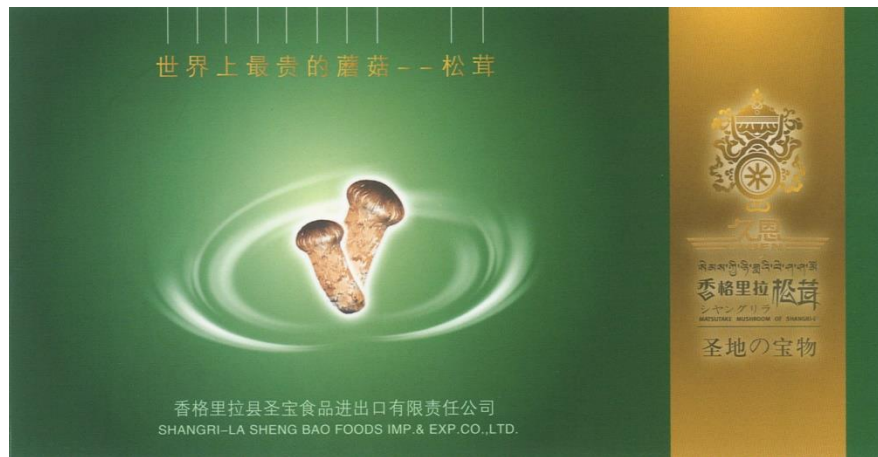
SHANGRI-LA MASTUTAKE SERIES (香格里拉松茸系列产)

Country of origin: China

Type of product: Fungus

Geographical Area: Diqing Prefecture, Yunnan Province

Specificity of the Product: Shangri-La is a rare and wild fungus, known as the "King of fungi." It grows at an altitude of 3,000 meters above sea level in a naturally pollution free environment. It grows in pine, coniferous, and broad-leaved mixed forest, as it is symbiotic with pine roots. It is also necessary for it to have oak trees and other broad-leaved forest around it to create shaded conditions. It also requires a certain temperature and humidity and a specific plateau geographical environment to allow it to grow. Compared with other funguses, the color is more fresh and it is more fragrant.
