

QIONGZHONG GREEN ORANGE (琼中绿橙)

Geographical Area: Hainan Province, Qiongzong County

Specificity of the Product: Qiongzong County is located on the northern edge of the tropical monsoon zone in the central mountains area of Hainan. It is located in the three rivers' birthplace, and has a reputation as a "green treasure". The land is fertile, abundant in light, with a mild climate and abundant rainfall. This area has a unique mountain climate characteristics. The fertile soil, high quality water, and absence of industrial pollution helps the Qiongzong green orange grow and contributes to the cultivation of good quality fruit. The peel of the Qiongzong orange peel is green and the meat inside is red. They are juicy, and moderately sweet and sour. Compared with ordinary oranges, they are rich in a lot of nutrients (B1, B2, C, Pectin etc.). Those orange are useful for building up the body's immune system.
