

GIANT SALAMANDER (正安娃娃鱼)

Specificity of the Product: The giant salamander is the world's largest remaining and most precious of amphibians. It sounds like children crying, so people called it "giant salamander." It has received national second-class protection for aquatic wildlife. The agriculture industry focuses on the development and characteristics of the agricultural species (they are farmed for food and traditional medicine); however wild ones are protected. They live mainly on the surface of low temperature karst depressions near the Yin River and in rich underground cave water. This type of environment is very suitable for the survival of the giant salamander.
