

## YANGBI WALNUT (漾濞核桃)

**Country of origin:** China

**Type of product:** Walnuts

**Geographical Area:** Dali Bai Autonomous Prefecture in Yunnan Province

**Specificity of the Product:** Dali has a long and splendid history and culture, romantic scenery of the four seasons, colorful ethnic customs, and is like a shining pearl on the southwest border of the China. Here the beautiful mountains and rivers, history, and unique geographical location and climate conditions have led to the famous Yangbi walnut. It is large, with a thin shell, and a nutrient-rich, dense kernel. Dali walnut cultivation has a long history, and there are many varieties being cultivated. As early as 3500 years ago, in the territory of the Lancang River there are walnut distribution. It was a commodity more than a thousand years ago, during the Song Dynasty Dali period. The Yangbi walnut is grown with attention to the Dali people's traditional varieties of cultivation, and over the years walnut cultivation has been widespread. The current Yangbi walnut cultivation area not only exists throughout the 12 counties and cities, the rest of the province and even many parts of the country have introduced the *Juglans sigillata* as the main variety, which has greatly improved the sustainability of walnut growing.
