Specificity of the Product: There records on the planting of this rice in "Shanglin County" (1985 edition). At the end of the twentieth century, people had been committed to self-sufficiency and paid more attention to the quality of rice varieties in the late Qing Dynasty. After the implementation of the co-production contract responsibility system, the enthusiasm of farmers grew, and rice production continues to increase. Now that there was surplus, people began to focus on the selection of some high-quality rice varieties. As a result of its good quality, Shanglin rice was always in high demand.
