According to research, the name and product called "rock feet" originated in the middle of the Qing Dynasty, produced in caves, with mineral water that is clear, sweet, rich in minerals and trace elements in the karst environment. It also uses high-quality wheat flour produced in the SAR as the main raw material. It also uses salt and vegetable oil. The product is rich in strontium, metasilicate, iodine, calcium carbonate, Zinc and other minerals – this comes from the natural mineral water that is used. Modern technology has refined the traditional method for the processing of the noodles.
