Specificity of the Product: Tian Dongxiang Mang nuclear is small with a rich, unique flavor that is sweet and refreshing.

In Tiandong County, the history of planting this mango goes back to the Tang Dynasty Kaiyuan years, according to historical records. The planting in the geographical area is mainly distributed in the right river valley Pingma town, Xiang Zhouzhen, Lin Fengzhen, Si Linzhen, and Deng Yao Township 5 Township. In 1972, technology began to be used for the cultivation of varieties of grafted seedlings, and the local soil was improved. This combined with the unique climate and soil conditions has led to the quality of this product. Over time it has become an important symbol and revenue source for the area.
