Specificity of the Product:

Longzai black barley is a unique highland barley cultivar of Longzai County in Shannan, Tibet, and grows in fields at an altitude of 3800 to 4200 meters. Because of its glume and grain epidermis, it appears black and purple. Its name comes from it being oval or diamond-shaped. Compared to ordinary white barley, it has a special high antioxidant and nutritional content.
