

XINGREN YIREN RICE (兴仁苡仁米)

Country of origin: China

Type of product: Barley

Geographical Area: Qianxinan Xingyi City of Guizhou Province Xingren County, Anlong, Zhenfeng, Puan County, Qinglong County, Ceheng County, Wangmo County

Specificity of the Product: Xingren, an important trading post on the Tea-Horse Road, is located in the center of eight counties in Panjiang, Xingyi, and Yunnan Province in southern Yunnan East of Guiyang and the South Gate of the main gateway. The area is located in the east 105 ° 54 'to 105 ° 34', latitude 25 ° 16 'to 25 ° 47'. The territory has an average elevation of 1253 meters and is in a moderate karst rocky desertification area. As the mountain is barren, Xingren residents found out a long time ago that, in addition to the medical value of barley rice, it also has a high nutritional value. Bitter buckwheat and barley rice were used during crop rotations. The soil in Xingren is mainly yellow soil, lime soil, and paddy soil. It is rich in iron but contains less calcium and magnesium ions. The soil is neutral and slightly acidic, loose and humid, and the climate is a warm and humid Monsoon climate with mild winters and summers. The light conditions are good for the growth of barely. The plants have ecological adaptability, and are undoubtedly growing in the best barley rice growth environment. Xingren folk say the barley is good because it can be grown in areas that other crops cannot be, does not use too much labor, and is a good source of income.
