Specificity of the Product:

Yanjing wine is produced 2200 to 2600 meters above sea level in the Tibet Autonomous Region in Qamdo Mangkang County. The local wine grapes are used as raw materials for the production of the wine. The area has a long history of brewing wine that can be traced back to the mid-19th century. Due to the unique geographical environment, bright color of the wine, mellow taste, and distinctive fragrance, it is widely known and in high demand in Tibetan areas. There are several varieties, including Black pearl, Cabernet Sauvignon, Snake Pearl, Merlot.
