#### **Updates on the EU GI review**



#### Context

- 2020: Announcement by the F2F strategy to revise the EU GI policy
- 31 March 2022: Publication of the legislative proposal by the Commission
- 20 April 2023 : Adoption of the position of the comAGRI in the EP
- May 2023 : Adoption of a common position of the Member States (Council)
- 31 May 2023 : Adoption of the position of the EP in Plenary
- Since June 2023: Trilogue negotiations between the EC, EP and Council (Spanish Presidency)
  - → End expected on 24 October 2023;

## **European Commission proposal**

- A single GI system for wine, spirit drinks and agricultural products
- Expanded role for the EUIPO: administrative tasks + delegated power for the EC to empower the EUIPO to scrutiny applications, opposition procedure, cancellation of GIs, operation of the GI register...
- Empower producer groups and recognized producer groups (new concept)
- Increase protection online and when GIs are used as ingredients but a definition of evocation
- Sustainability: include elements in the product specifications + delegated power on the definition
- Cancellation of EU audits of GI control systems

# oriGIn EU priorities

- Ensure that the European Commission is in charge of the examination and analysis of GI product specifications
  - → No delegation of competences to the EUIPO for the examination of product specification
  - → The EUIPO can support the GI system on IP components, protection...
- **Strengthen** the role of Producer groups/Recognised producer groups while **maintaining what is functioning**. Give additional tasks to recognised producer groups

## oriGIn EU priorities

#### Enhanced GI protection :

- → online: country & top-level domain names, ex officio,
- → as an ingredient, and in processed food
- → introduction of feta case
- > no definition of evocation
- → when a GI is cancelled
- $\rightarrow$  ect...

#### Better define sustainability

- introduce 3 pillars: environmental, economic and social
- → no delegated act
